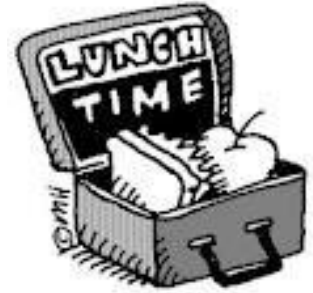


CHS Lunch Plus Expectations

Lunch Plus is to allow 30 minutes for students to eat lunch and 30 minutes to engage in the activities below.

Lunch Plus Will Offer the Following Opportunities to Students:

- Receive Required Intervention/Remediation/Tutoring
 - Monday – Math
 - Tuesday – English
 - Wednesday – Science
 - Thursday – Social Studies
- Make Up Tests and Quizzes
- Get Extra Help from Their Teachers
- Work on School Work, Projects, and Homework
- See Guidance Counselors
- Participate in Sports/Activities in the Gym – Friday A lunch – PBIS incentive 5 CAVS cash



Students May Eat in the Following Areas:

- Cafeteria
- Classrooms with Teacher Supervision
- Student may eat in the science classrooms, **but not at lab stations.**
- Students may gather in media (Quiet Room), but food or drink is not allowed.

Areas off Limits:

- Parking Lots and Fields
- Any Classroom Without Teacher Supervision
- West Side of Building
- CTA (unless previously given a pass from a CTA teacher)
- Auditorium & Atrium
- Hallways and Stairwells

General Expectations:

Students will:

- Attend mandatory intervention/remediation/tutoring sessions on the assigned day.
- Participate in the activity in the gym (No food or spectators permitted.) – A lunch only.
- Report to their destination within **five minutes** of the bell ringing for each lunch session.
- **Have a signed pass in hand when leaving a room during A or B lunch.**
- **Be sent directly to an assigned location** if in the halls without a signed pass during lunch.
- Only leave the cafeteria during A and B lunch with food items as a pass and must have a pre-determined destination.
- **Not be excused from a classroom or the cafeteria in the final 5 minutes of both A and B lunch.**
- **Have only ONE headphone/earbud** in and maintain a reasonable volume during lunch plus.
- Remain on campus during lunch.
- Arrive to 5th period on time.
- Respect the school by cleaning up and throwing away all food and trash when they leave an area during lunch plus, this includes: the cafeteria, all classrooms, and the hallways.

Consequences:

- Students who leave campus during lunch will lose Lunch Plus privileges. Student drivers may lose their parking privilege as well.
- Any behavioral problems during lunch will lead to automatic lunch detention.
- Students found in the hallway without a pass multiple times will lose Lunch Plus privileges.
- Lunch detentions can begin immediately (same day) and/or be reserved for a later date.
- Lunch detention will be held daily in Room 222.
