

Calvert High School
Student Parking Criteria

Eligibility: SENIORS AND JUNIORS ONLY with a valid driver's license, proper automobile insurance, less than 12 days absence in the previous year, and no outstanding financial obligations.

Permits will be issued in the following order of priority:

1. Seniors with less than a whole day.
2. Seniors and juniors with good attendance.
3. Seniors and juniors participating in Calvert High after-school activities **with signatures**.
4. Seniors – first come first serve basis.
5. Juniors - first come first serve basis.

Procedures: Submit a completed application to the main office. (Incomplete applications will be returned.) Applications will be reviewed and given appropriate consideration. Approved students must show their driver's license to receive the parking permit. **All cars must have the appropriate permit by SEPTEMBER 15, 2017.**

Fee: \$60.00 if purchased prior to 11/15/17 \$40.00 if purchased 11/15/17 - 2/28/18
\$20.00 if purchased 3/1/18 – Last Day of School \$20.00 for replacement of a lost permit
ANYONE DRIVING WITHOUT A PERMIT WILL INCUR A FINANCIAL OBLIGATION.

Student Parking Regulations

Students in violation of any of the regulations below may lose their privilege to drive to school.

(Reminder: Driving is a privilege!)

1. You are responsible for your vehicle while it is on school property. **No** other student may drive your vehicle. **DO NOT** give your keys to other students.
2. Students will not be allowed to park at the end of the rows outside the designated spaces.
3. Students must follow the established traffic patterns.
4. Student drivers are expected to be in class no later than 7:40 a.m. **NO LOITERING** will be permitted in the parking area. There are consequences if you are tardy. (see the back of this page)
5. Student drivers will drive **no faster than 10 mph** on school property. A driver who abuses the speed limit or drives in an unsafe manner will lose parking privileges. This includes entering and exiting Fox Run Blvd. and Dorsey Rd.
6. Cars are not allowed to be running **unattended** and all cars must be locked.
7. Reckless driving (squealing tires, inappropriate passing, etc.) and horseplay – riding on hoods, running boards, fenders etc. are prohibited and will not be tolerated. This will result in immediate revocation of the parking pass.
8. **Students are not permitted to go to the parking lot during school hours unless an administrator has given prior approval.**
9. Student drivers requiring early dismissal must bring a note from his/her parent/guardian and follow normal procedures for early dismissal.
10. **Students are not allowed to transfer their parking permit to another student or to a car not listed on this application.** Violators will lose their parking permit. (Even if you are riding with that student.) If you get a new vehicle it must be registered (make, model, color and license plate number) with Mrs. Jones **PRIOR** to you driving it to school.
11. Any infraction of the "Student Code of Conduct" that results in a 10 day out of school suspension and a Board Hearing may result in permanent revocation of the parking permit.
12. Permits (static) must be clearly displayed on the **bottom, driver's side, corner of the windshield** while in the parking lot. If you are changing cars with your parents/guardians for the day, you must still have your permit or you will not be allowed in the parking lot.

13. Students will be dismissed from the student lots by 2:50 p.m. No vehicles are to leave without being dismissed by a staff member. NO LOITERING will be permitted in the parking area. ALL students MUST leave unless involved in an after-school activity.
14. You must keep your parking pass readable and **DARK** at all times (please “re-sharpie” it throughout the year).

Laws Impacting Teens

(These are 2 of 6 laws that will impact the student driver while at CHS)

1. House Bill 393 – Prohibits passengers under the age of 18 not related to the driver from riding in the car for the first five months (151 days) that the driver has a provisional driver’s license.
2. House Bill 394 – Prohibits a holder of a learner’s permit or a provisional driver’s license who is under the age of 18 from using a cell phone while driving unless there is an emergency.

Day revocation refers to the number of school days your parking permit will be suspended. Offenses other than those listed above will be subject to a penalty imposed by the administration.

Attention all student drivers!!

You **MUST** report to the student parking lots **IMMEDIATELY** after school unless you are participating in an after-school activity. You also may not go out front to the bus area or you will lose your parking privilege.

Early Release Students

Students on early release **CANNOT** return to school unless participating in an after-school activity. Early Release students are **NOT** permitted to return to school during Lunch Plus or bring lunch for other students during this time period. Violation of this policy will result in parking permit revocation.
